
We look forward to everyone returning on April 19th with renewed enthusiasm for a great summer.

Changes relating to school access and safety

Our pupils' safety is of paramount importance to us, so we'd like to make you aware of some changes regarding access to school. These will come into effect on Monday 23rd April:

- A playground barrier will be in operation from 3.40 pm until 4.45 pm each day. Fobs for Nursery parents or those with special access requirements are available to purchase from the school office.
- Parents who are dropping off children in the morning wrap-around care or whom are collecting children in the evenings from this provision should go to the Lower Prep playground gate and press the button on the intercom unit to gain entry. Exit will be from here also.
- Parents wishing to attend the Breakfast Club will be able to do so via the main playground pedestrian gate, and will be allowed in to the Dining Room by the supervising staff member. Exit from the Breakfast Club will be by returning back into the playground and out of the main gates.
