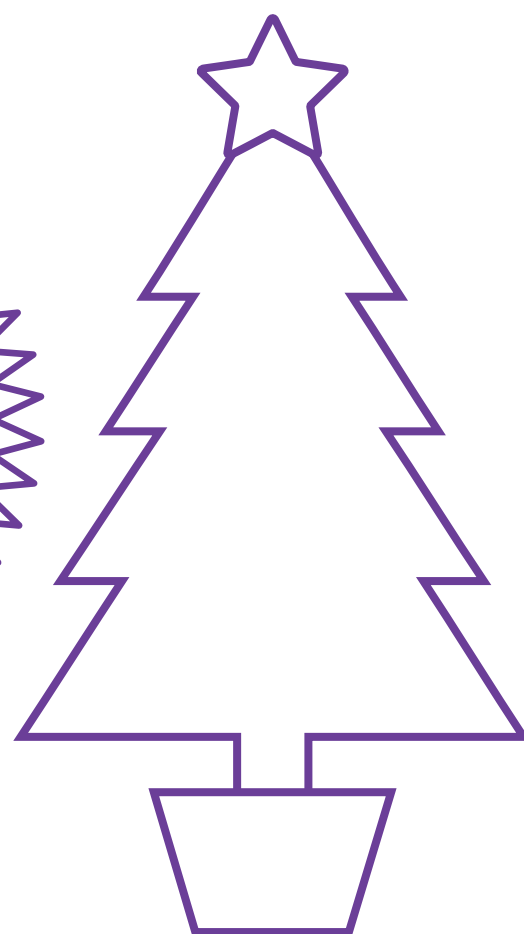
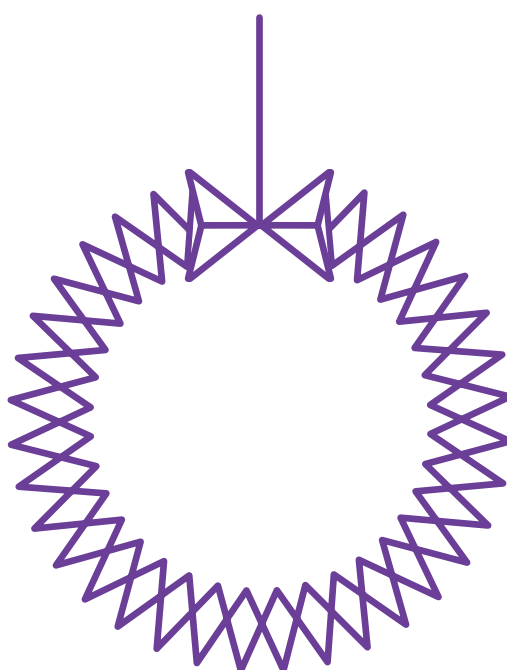
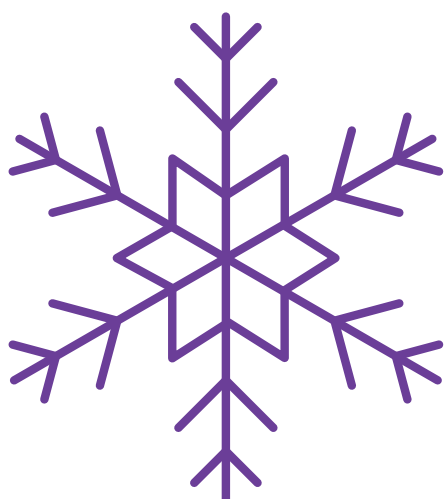

Crafty shopping list

- Blank cards
- Embroidery thread and a needle
- Scissors
- Blu tack
- Cork mat (optional)

How to make



1 Cut out your chosen design from the front of this template, leaving a box of white space around it.

Place the design on top of a blank card. Make sure it's straight, and use blu tack to fix it temporarily in place.

Using a needle, punch holes for your thread through the front of your card using the design as a guideline.

Make holes at every corner and every join between two lines.

Place a cork mat inside the card to stop the needle piercing the back.

Crafty variations

Thread carefully placed beads into your design to add berries to your Christmas wreath, or colourful baubles to your tree!

Remove your paper design and the blu tack. Thread your needle with embroidery thread and tie a knot at one end.

Using a back stitch, start connecting the dots. Use the design to guide you. Once complete, secure at the back with another knot.

You've finished! Time to finish it off with a Christmassy message, and send on to someone special.
