As a stunning start to our new topic about Toys, Year 1 went on a visit to the Leather Museum.


They began their visit by making a Chinese Dragon puppet out of

Year 1 then examined the skins of an alligator and cobra










Pupils spent the final part of the day making their own keyring out of leather with gold leaf blocking.




