## Nursery W/c 13 Mor 23

This week marked the beginning of Anti-bullying week where Nursery children focussed on acts of kindness and reinforced the meaning of our Nursery rules. The children have been challenged a 7 day kindness challenge, and throughout the week the children and have been completing specific tasks.

Day 1 - the children smiled at their friends & shared toys.

Day 2 - the children were tasked with kind words and understand their meaning.

Collectively as a group the children each chose a colour to make a 'Handprint Heart of Kindness'. A discussion was had during the activity of how each child could be kind to someone. The children recorded their thoughts and feelings.

Day 3 - the children focussed on using their magic words (please and thank you) and encouraging others to be kind.

We talked collectively as a group about magic words and what they mean.

To follow on from this the children made a 'Good Friend Hand Wreath' by decorating a hand and commenting about what makes a good friend.

The children made the following comments,

Khushie - "Be kind and hold hands with my mommy".

Nishaan - "Be best friends".

Jiya - "Use kind words and if somebody falls down, I help them to get up".

Amaya - "Hold someone's hand".

Veeran - "No kicking and hold hands when walking".

Day 4 – The children focussed on using our listening ears to really listen to someone and care about what they are saying. Our follow up activity is to make a 'friendship sun catcher'.

Day 5 – Challenge is when the children were challenged to help each other, remembering to put things back where they belong and begin to have an understanding of why it is important to be kind to others.

What a fabulous week we have had, succeeding in our kindness goals.

## **Road Safety Week**

Stop Look & Listen

Nursery children have really embraced the meaning of Road Safety this week. Our group discussions and children's comments demonstrated a good comprehension of the importance of the subject. We talked about the following aspects:

- The importance of holding hands with an adult when near or crossing a road
- The difference between the footpath and the road
- Using the Green Cross Code: Stop, Look, Listen
- Being safe within a car (using seat belts, car seats etc)
- Being safe on a scooter (using helmets, controlling speed etc)
- Recognising key traffic signs and noises

Nursery children took the activity to the next level as they acted out a role-play scenario on this theme.

All pupils have received a leaflet containing 9 activities to complete in November that will reduce their carbon footprint. Maybe some new habits will continue into the new year!




